A Place of Initiation



The destination's interactive adventure builder, Little Adventures, guides families through their exploration of a collection of activities, expertly curated by local residents, to build an itinerary that best suits their children's ages, skillset and interests. Kids as young as one can enjoy an afternoon splashing and discovering wildlife in crystal clear tide pools. Budding marine biologists will find themselves an arm's reach away from marine life on, and in some instances, under the water. Young explorers can chart their own course via kayak or paddleboard, and teens can challenge themselves to take a lesson out on the water and leave with a new skill like suba diving or eFoiling.

"The World's Luckiest Fishing Village"

Affectionately known as the "World's Luckiest Fishing Village," Destin boasts the largest commercial charter fishing fleet in the country, guaranteeing families an unforgettable day offshore year-round. It's a reminder that a child doesn't need an actual catch to make a fishing trip successful. Children remember the day, no matter what was – or wasn't – caught, ultimately walking away with a fish tale of their own as a prized souvenir.

Fishing outings vary to best suit first-timers and seasoned anglers alike, ranging from offshore excursions with the



expert guidance of an experienced charter captain, to enjoying the peaceful bayous and bays in a kayak or paddleboard, to casting a line from the fishing pier or along the beautiful shores.

Appalachian quartz crystals, washed from rivers and tumbled by the tides over thousands of years, have formed the fine white powder sand that exists today, creating the trademark emerald color that results from reflecting sunlight through the surf.
